Joseph White Building Adds New Tenant

Foster and Adoptive Care Coalition Leases 9,000 SF



Foster and Adoptive Care Coalition of Greater St. Louis leased 9,093 square feet at the Joseph H. White Building at 1750 S. Brentwood Blvd. in Brentwood, MO. Occupancy is scheduled for Fall 2010.

The eight-story, 74,568-square-foot office building was constructed in 1964 in the Clayton submarket.

The coalition will create a Foster and Adoption Resource Center in the space that will focus on creating a one-stop community support center for all local foster and adoptive families, provide office space to improve upon existing services and to expand the newly developed ground-breaking adoption program named Extreme Recruitment.

The coalition will also introduce 'Karma, a hip and fresh resale shop providing gently used clothing to youth in foster care at bargain prices. Karma will be offering volunteer opportunities for up to 500 youth and young adults and will be open to the general public as well.
